Some voters will need to show ID

- First-time voters; and
- Those voting at a new polling place for the first time.

Plan ahead

Pick out the ID you will use on Election Day, from the list of approved forms of identification. Put it where you will need it.

Approved forms of photo identification:

(ID must be valid)

- PA driver's license or ID card issued by PennDOT
- ID issued by any other Commonwealth agency
- ID issued by the U.S. Government
- U.S. Passport
- U.S. Armed Forces ID
- Student ID
- Employee ID

Approved forms of non-photo identification:

(ID must include the name and address of the elector)

- Voter's identification card issued by the voter registration commission
- Non-photo ID issued by the Commonwealth
- Non-photo ID issued by the U.S. Government
- Firearm permit
- Current utility bill
- Current bank statement
- Current paycheck
- Government check

On Election Day:


- ⇒ if you find yourself at the polls without ID, and no time to get home, or
- ⇒ if your name is not on the list of approved voters in your precinct, the election workers must offer you a Provisional Ballot.

Pennsylvania law:

the county board of elections must compare the signature on the Provisional Ballot envelope with the signature on the elector's registration form and, if the signatures are determined to be genuine, the ballot is counted.
